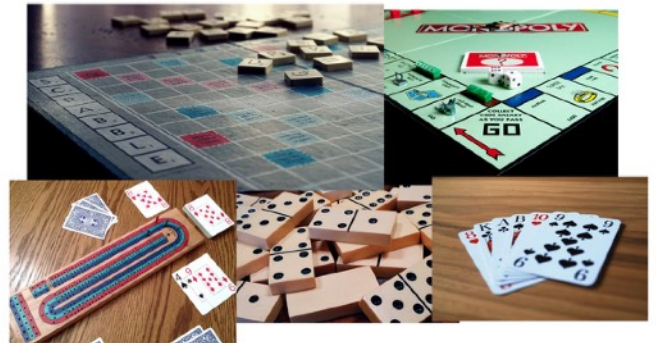

Buildings & Grounds

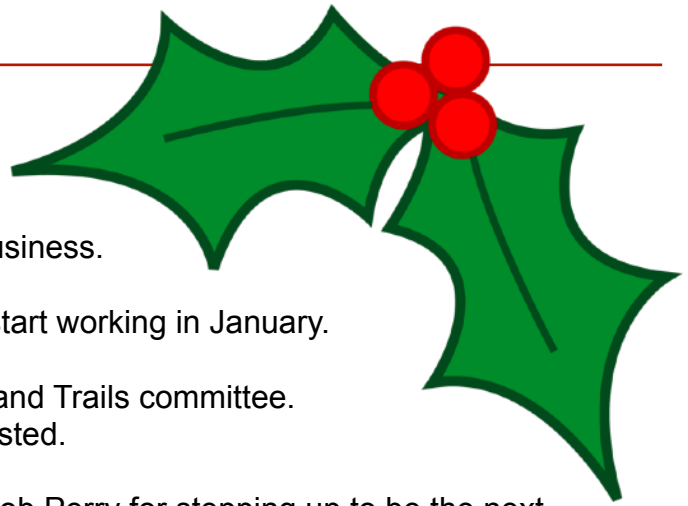
