

Continuing Operations of The Longbranch Marina

In the interest of continuing to operate The Longbranch Marina during the Covid-19 outbreak we are adhering to the following protocols.

Please contact the Dock Master, Katie Harrison at 253-202-2056 when you arrive at the marina. She will record your vessel number and register you. Payments may be made via Pay Pal on The Longbranch Improvement Club website www.licweb.org or via the drop box in the pavilion at the marina. Cash or check only will be accepted at the drop box. If you choose to pay by credit card, please fill out a guest moorage envelope and post it on your vessel so that we have your registration information.

Guests are asked to bag and seal their garbage before placing in the cans provided - use commercially available plastic bags only. Our garbage hauler has asked that no loose garbage be put in the container. Also, we continue to recycle as much material as possible. Please assist us in keeping the marina and our surrounding environment as clean as possible.

We request that all guests practice safety protocols recommended by the CDC:

- **Social Distancing:** Please leave a space of 6' between all except members of your family. Note the 6' tape at the entrance to the pavilion.
- **Hygiene:** Wash your hands! We have provided a hand wash station just outside the marina gate. We will be sanitizing the high touch areas of the marina at least once a day and appreciate your participation in sanitizing during your stay.

Our Dock Master will only conduct business with you via the window on the east side of the pavilion. Please Do Not Enter the Dock Master's office.

Pavilion Etiquette:

While some may be unconcerned about the spread of the virus, others are very concerned and may be at high risk. Please respect others and observe the 6' distancing protocols recommended by health experts. If you utilize the tables and chairs in the pavilion, please sanitize them when finished. The sooner we stop the spread of the virus, the sooner our lives return to normal. Any one participating in activities that are uncomfortable for others using the marina may be asked to leave without a refund of their moorage fees.
