
**The Longbranch Foundation Student Programs Committee dedicates this quilt to the students and staff of Evergreen Elementary on the opening of their new school in 2021.**

The Vision of the Foundation is “A Thriving and Sustainable South Key Community.” In order to obtain this lofty vision, we all must care for each other and the natural world around us.



**Secretary's Report:** Sheryl requested that the minutes of last month's membership meeting be approved as written and submitted in the newsletter. MSP

**Treasurer's Report:** Jim Hettinger reported that we were \$17,000 over the net income of budgeted \$1,300.

**Events:** Bob Green reported that the Trunk or Treat event went well, and many kids were served candy.

- Deck the Halls is planned for the first Saturday in December, the 4th, at 10 AM, to put all the Christmas decorations up. Please bring greens to put up. There will be hot drinks and snacks.
- KIDS N CHRISTMAS: December 12, 2021 from 1 pm to 3 PM. Santa will be distributing presents, and parents can take pictures of their kids.
- All events will need volunteers.
- Member meeting for December: We will be commemorating our Centennial with a raffle and prizes, games and a

period dress, from the 1920's. Food will be provided.

**Buildings and Grounds:** Jim Sobieck thanked David Starkweather for getting the stage lights activated. We still need volunteers to help with clean up. Katie Voyce is our new rental agent for the LIC hall.

We will celebrate first with the planting of a Red Cedar at 4 PM on the 15th with the meeting at 6 PM. We have many more events planned throughout the year to commemorate our Centennial experience.

**President:** Kelly announced that we would like to try to fill the gap that BLEND is leaving since they closed, and he is proposing every third Friday, a TGIF hosted here at the LIC in the foyer from 5 – 8 PM to create continuity for the community. Kelly is looking for feedback on this idea, and we are investigating a liquor license for those nights.

**Foundation report:** Michele Gorman reported about the Celebrate campaign and the mission and activities of the Foundation. She said she received a text from a scholarship recipient who is finishing community college and has been accepted at a four-year University to continue his education due to our help. We support students at Evergreen Elementary and KP Middle School with scholarships and funding for projects. We have created a mini-grant program at KPMS and have received the first requested mini-grant for a cooking program with students.
